pursue other programs and was allowed to intern at the Wake County Court House. Soon she

received an apartment and has been moving forward every since. She enrolled at Phoenix University in 2012 and is an honor student. Darlene

has been a member of Triumph In Christ Christian Center in Raleigh NC for two years. She also helped manage women who were housed through Beauty for Ashes Outreach Ministries. Darlene sees her life through the eyes of Christ and refuses to see it any other way.
